

**1. Whether educational institutions are eligible for MSME Udyam registration?**

Yes

**2. Do individuals with 5 – 6 firms need to register as single MSME unit or each firm will have separate registration number?**

Based on PAN card of the individual, only one registration is required. Multiple number of units can be added to this single registration number.

**3. Most of the micro industries do not have certificate of incorporation. How do they proceed in the Udyam form as it is asking for the date of incorporation?**

The day of the puja or the date of commencement of the business can be taken as the date of incorporation.

**4. Is it mandatory to fill multiple addresses?**

Not required. If an unit has same address for production office and corporate office, single address can be entered. If both are different, two addresses need to be furnished.

**5. What are the days and timing of the courses offered by MSME DI ? How does one obtain the course materials? Is online training available?**

Courses are of full day duration from 10 am to 3 pm. Biometric attendance is mandatory. Online courses are not available.

**6. Why do some customers face difficulty in receiving the OTP if there is a change in the registered mobile number?**

OTPs are generated to the aadhaar registered mobile numbers only.

**7. Based on the latest announcement, retail and wholesale traders are eligible for MSMEs. Can they register in Udyam portal?**

Yes, they can register in Udyam portal. But they are eligible only for Priority Sector Lending (PSL) and not for MSME schemes. When it comes to the preference, manufactures are given priority followed by service sector and then only traders.

**8. Are individuals involved in trade/services, especially street vendors eligible for Udyam registration?**

Right now, the trader should have at least 100 sq.ft office space in order to be eligible for MSME.

**9. What is Sundaram Finance doing to promote Udyam registration?**

Sundaram Finance has made Udyam registration mandatory for all its SME customers and are guiding them on why it is made mandatory.

**10. PAN, Aadhaar and GST are mandatory for Udyam registration?**

PAN and Aadhaar are mandatory. GST is optional.

**11. What would be the percentage of depreciation when applied through Udyam, for machinery worth Rs 70 lakhs?**

This depends entirely on auditor's calculation. Generally, it is 5-10%.

**12. As an ISO consultant, can I do Udyam registration?**

**13. If the mobile number as per aadhaar is lost/old, can we add one more mobile number?**

In case Aadhaar is lost, after obtaining new Aadhaar, the entrepreneur can update his new Aadhaar in Udyam portal. If number is inactive, he/she can update his mobile number in Aadhaar and enter the updated Aadhaar in Udyam portal.
